Things To Know:

Illness: Please help our class stay healthy. If you or your child are coughing, sneezing, or have a runny nose with a green discharge, please keep your child home. If we do notice that your child is not feeling well, we will notify you immediately. If your child has a fever, they will need to stay home for 24 hours after the fever has broken.

<u>Birthdays</u>: You may bring healthy, bite-sized snacks for the celebrations (ex. fruits, mini cupcakes, mini yogurt cups, etc). In lieu of goodie bags, may we request your child donate a book to the classroom library with his/her name on it, toys for indoor or outdoor play, or science experiment materials.

Sharing: We will have sharing days every Friday. Your child is welcome to bring a book or a special item (ex. souvenirs, trophies, pictures, etc) to share during our group circle time.

<u>Snacks</u>: The school will provide a healthy snack which will be served in the morning. If your child would like to bring his/her own snacks, we do ask that they be healthy. <u>Please also remember that Arborland is a nut-free school</u>.

<u>Finished Work</u>: Your child's work will be sent home every day. Please do not be alarmed if your child does not have any or much work in their folder. Many of the Montessori materials do not require paperwork.

Helpful Reminders

- Each child is welcome to bring in their own play dough.
- The children will be provided with all other school supplies such as pencils, glue sticks, scissors, etc.
- If your child will be bringing lunch from home, please make sure the lunch pail is cleaned every day. Same routine for water bottles.
- Each child will need a ziploc bag, labeled with their name, with a set of extra clothes.
 - 2 pairs of socks
 - 2 shirts
 - 2 bottoms
 - 2 underwear
- Nappers (children 3 years & younger) will need a crib sized sheet and blanket. Please bring nap items in a bag. These will go home every Friday to be washed and returned on Monday.
- Please label any and all personal belongings with child's name.
