Any work your child produces will be placed in the blue folders on the cubbies or on the bench after school. Please do not be concerned if your child does not have paperwork to take home. Many of the materials do not require added worksheets. I will try to post pictures on Transparent Classroom every week or two. If you have any questions on the purpose of activities, I am happy to explain.

Items Needed

Each child should bring:

- 2 shirts
- 2 bottoms
- 2 underwear
- 2 socks

Items should be labeled in a ziplock bag and placed in your child's cubby.

- If your child is under 4 years old, please provide them with a crib sized sheet and blanket for nap time. They may bring a stuffed friend to sleep with.
- Please have your child bring a reusable water bottle. We have a Brita filter and will refill water bottles during the day.
- Any optional program items can be hung on the wall hooks opposite of the cubbies.

Helpful Information

- Bring your child on time between 8:30-9 am to avoid distractions after 9 am.
- Help your child gain independence starts at home. Give your child time to do things for themselves.
- **Label everything.** Many times children have the same items.
- Home lunches should be placed in your child's cubby. If your child needs to bring a small backpack, please leave it outside Door #4.
- Snack is provided by the school during morning work time.
- Nap items will be sent home to wash on Fridays. Please return them on Monday.
- Share time is on Monday in the afternoon. Encourage your child to practice what they'd like to talk about when sharing.
- Birthdays are important to us and we would love to teach the children about the passage of time. Please take the time to fill out the birthday timeline to help us celebrate your child's life. Instead of goodie bags, consider donating a book or plant to the classroom. They may share a snack with the class.
