Dear Arborland Families,

As we are less than 2 weeks away from the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year, we would like to remind everyone of Arborland's COVID-19 safety procedures. COVID-19 cases are increasing again with the evolution of variants and vaccinated people do have the possibility of getting COVID. Since the pandemic is a continually evolving situation, we will continue to make necessary adjustments to protect our families and our school community. Please see the Q&A below for the most updated information:

Q1: My student is not vaccinated. Does Arborland require a COVID negative test to return to in-person school?

A: Yes. All students must show proof of a COVID-19 negative test result from a test taken between 3-7 days before returning to school in-person.

Q2: The adults in my family are not vaccinated. Does Arborland require a negative COVID test from us, the parents/guardians, for my child to return to in-person school?

A: Yes, any parent/guardian who is not vaccinated must show proof of their own COVID-19 negative test result taken between 3-7 days before the student can return to in-person school.

Q3: My student is vaccinated. Does Arborland require a COVID negative test to return to in-person school?

A: No, the student does not need to show proof of a negative COVID test result if the student can provide a vaccination card instead.

Q4: The adults in my family are vaccinated. Does Arborland require a negative COVID test from us, the parents/guardians, for my child to return to in-person school?

A: No, the parents/guardians do not need to show proof of a negative COVID test result if they can provide proof of vaccination instead.

Q5: Will Arborland be requiring monthly COVID testing of in-person students and staff?

A: Not at this time. We understand that resources are limited. Monthly testing without symptoms or possible exposure would take away resources from those who need it the most. However, in order to protect everyone's safety, Arborland will make adjustments based on the status of the pandemic.

Q6: Will my child be required to wear facemasks all day?

A: No. All staff and students are required to wear facemasks indoors, regardless of vaccination status. However, facemasks may be removed during snack time, meal times and nap time. Facemasks are optional outdoors. Please email your child's teacher if you would like your child to take off his/her facemask outdoors.

Q7: What additional COVID-19 safety precautions will Arborland be following?

A: Arborland will also be following the safety precautions below:

- Temperature checks upon arrival for students. Those with a temperature of 100.4° or higher will need to stay home.
- A COVID-19 screening questionnaire will be sent home by email 3-7 days prior to the first day of school. Parents/guardians are responsible for answering the questionnaire for those living in the child's household.

Again, we want to emphasize that WE ALL ARE IN THIS TOGETHER AND NEED YOUR HELP to continue to keep our campus open safely. Your support is greatly appreciated.
